## Eligibility Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded to a student who is interested in becoming a crime analyst or to a current employee of an agency with the criminal justice system. Any students applying should be in a certification or degree program at a college or university associated with the northwest.

## Restrictions

1. NORCAN board members are not eligible to apply for scholarships. Reviewers of essays may not be related to any applicant.

## Requirements:

- Essay is to have a 1000 word maximum. Your essay may answer one or both questions listed below.
- Essays must be submitted in PDF format to [norcan.conference@outlook.com](mailto:norcan.conference@outlook.com) no later than midnight PDT October 30, 2020.
- No special characters or symbols in your essay.
- Must be submitted in English.
- Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

## How to Apply

The application includes a maximum 1,000-word essay that incorporates answers to the following questions

### Topics:

Why do you want / why did you become a crime analyst and what would be one of the projects you would look into as an analyst?

What do you hope to learn at the 2021 NORCAN conference and how do you anticipate applying that knowledge in your current or future career?

**Application package will include**

1. Scholarship application
2. Essay
3. If not currently employed as an analyst or in law enforcement, provide a letter from a faculty advisor or acceptance letter from academic institution, including the name, telephone number, and mailing address of the Registrar for the school you are attending.
